

Travel Information



Approximate mileage:

From Sea/Tac International Airport: 211 miles, 4 hours 30 min driving time.

From Wenatchee: 108 miles, 2 hours driving time.

The Methow Valley is home to the largest mule deer population and the slowest grouse in Washington State. Many of these creatures will attempt to cross the road in front of your car or motorcycle. Please drive carefully!

Directions from Seattle area:

- 1 Take 405N/I-5/Renton, merge onto 518 E, continue onto I-405 N, 23.2 mi
- 2 Exit 23 toward Woodinville/Wenatchee/US-2, merge onto 522 E, 0.6 mi
- 3 Exit onto US-2 E/Stevens Pass Highway. Continue on Highway 2 following signs to East Wenatchee/Okanogan, crossing the Columbia River
- 4 Turn left at the junction with Highway 2 & 97 meet and continue north to Okanogan/Orondo/Brewster/Pateros. This route follows the east side of the Columbia River and is a faster route than 97A. Continue on Highway 97 towards Okanogan, bearing left at the junction at Orondo where Highway 2 turns right to Spokane, 58 mi
- 5 Turn left at Pateros onto Highway 153 N/Methow Valley Hwy and continue straight onto Hwy 20/Twisp Winthrop, 82.9 mi
- 6 Just past milepost 196, turn left onto Twin Lakes Road, about 6 miles past Twisp.
- 7 1.9 miles up Twin Lakes Road, turn left onto Patterson Lake Road and continue up past the lake for 6.3 miles to the lodge.

Fly into commercial Pangborn Memorial Airport, located four miles from downtown Wenatchee. Pangborn provides daily flights to and from Seattle via Horizon Air. The airport offers charter air services, car rentals,

Directions from Wenatchee Airport to Sun Mountain Lodge:

- 1 Head east on Pangborn Rd toward S Airport Way, 0.1 mi
- 2 At the traffic circle, take the 3rd exit onto Grant Rd, 3.9 mi
- 3 Turn right onto WA-28 W, 4.4 mi
- 4 Continue onto US-2 E/US-97 N/Sunset Hwy, continue to follow US-97 N, 52.2 mi
- 5 Turn left at Methow Valley Hwy/WA-153 N (signs for WA-20/Twisp Winthrop), 30.7 mi
- 6 Turn left onto Twin Lakes Rd, 1.9 mi
- 7 Turn left onto Patterson Lake Rd, 6.3 mi
